


Colorectal Cancer (CRC) Burden

- 2nd Leading Cause of Cancer Death
- Estimated New Cases in 2021 149,500
- Estimated Deaths in 2021 52,980
- Yet, 23 million individuals have not been screened → 85% are Insured











Illinois CRC Screening Rates by Counties and Resource Capacity for Colonoscopies












Our Fragmented Healthcare System

- Linkage to specialty care services with follow-up reporting










Our Solution: How Does It Work?
